Obligations

MSS Management is responsible for providing and maintaining:

- Any information, instruction, training and supervision needed to make sure that all workers are safe from injury and risks to their health
- Personal protective equipment
- Proper waste management and infection control guidelines
- Information, instruction, training and supervision that is reasonably necessary to ensure that each worker is safe from injury and risks to health
- A commitment to consult and co-operate with workers in all matters relating to health and safety in the workplace
- A commitment to continually improve our performance through effective safety management.

Workers are responsible for:

- · Ensuring their own personal health and safety, and that of others in the workplace
- Complying with any reasonable directions (such as safe work procedures, wearing personal protective equipment) given by management for health and safety
- Ensure the health and safety of visitors, contractors and patients by following the MSS protocols, procedures and guidelines.
- Reporting breaches of guidelines, accidents, incidents and near misses, no matter how trivial.
- Striving to improve the workplace, making suggestions and recommendations to MSS management where areas of improvement or possible risks are identified.
- Not misusing or interfering with anything provided for health and safety
- Following, supporting and adhering to the Health and Safety Policies of our clients on the work site where MSS is engaged.
- Disposing of all waste in appropriate manner that has zero impact on the environment and does not pose a risk to any person
